**A BILL**

For

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ENGLISH BECOME THE STATE'S OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

BE IT ENACTED by the legislature of The American Legion Wonderful Wyoming Boys' State:

- Section 1: Definitions
- a. Except as otherwise provided in this act
    - i. English means the written and spoken language, or reasonable facsimile thereof, originating, and spoken in the British Islands
    - ii. Government business means all official government business which includes, but is not limited to, bills, laws, orders, instructions, voting bills, and records. This term also means verbal communications.
- Section 2: English is the official language. English shall be the official language of the Government of the State of Wyoming.
- Section 3: governmental business to be in English. All governmental business shall be Conducted in written or spoken English.
- Section 4: exceptions to English language requirements
- a. In all courts and administrative tribunals, and in other governmental proceedings as Deemed necessary, where the proceedings directly affect a non-English speaking Person, verbal and written communications may be made at the time of the proceedings.....
