An Act for naptime mandates in all of Wyoming State Legislature

Section 1. Definitions:

Naptime is a 20-30 minute period of time wherein rest or sleep is usually applied during the afternoon only

Section 2. All people in the State of Wyoming are required, but are not limited to, one naptime per day. Wherein, all citizens are to take time to rest and or sleep to feel refreshed and continue more motivated work afterward.

Section 3. If a citizen waives their right to naptime, then they will be punished to the fullest extent of the law. Whereby, skipping naptime would be a felony under state law with a punishment of 7 days in jail and a 700.000 fine to be served by the offender.
